

MSW Boys Upcoming Representative Season Information

Nominations for under 14's and 15's will close on Sunday 18th July and players in these age groups will receive their invitation email from MSW on Monday 19th July 2021.

Nominations for under 13's and under 12's will close Sunday 15th August and players in these age groups will receive their invitation email from MSW on Monday 16th August 2021.

If your child does not receive an email and you believe they should be trialling for MSW this season, please speak your MSW Club.

Trials-

Trials for each age group are as follows:

- U12: Sunday 29 August (morning), Sunday 5 September (morning), Sunday 12 September (morning) @ Macgregor CC (mornings)
- U13: Sunday 29 August (morning), Sunday 5 September (afternoon), Sunday 12 September (afternoon) @ Macgregor CC
- U14: Sunday 1 August (afternoon), Sunday 8 August (afternoon), Sunday 22 August (afternoon) @ South Brisbane DCC
- U15: Sunday 1 August (afternoon), Sunday 8 August (morning), Sunday 22 August (morning, TBC)

Trial Games and Training

Trial games will likely occur through October and November (might be a trial in December but TBC). There will be a maximum of three trials per team. As always training is optional but recommended prior to the carnival, and sessions occur at the coaches discretion.

Carnivals

As a general rule, QJC/QC Carnivals occur through mid December and the Development Carnivals will be through the first full week of January.

MSW Qualification Criteria

MSW are asking all Clubs to ensure they nominate any player they feel is comfortable to play a higher standard of cricket, displays the attributes of a representative cricketer and meets MSW qualification criteria for representative selection, a player must:

- * Be registered with a MSW affiliated Club
- * Be nominated by their MSW affiliated Club
- * Attend all the trials
- * Attend all practice sessions and trial games
- * Play at least 5 of the 9 weeks in a MSW competition or Queensland Cricket sanctioned competition (for example, Taverners)
- * Be available to attend the South Conference Carnival

If a player fails to meet any of the above criteria, then they will not be eligible to represent MSW. A player may be withdrawn by the MSW Management Committee at any time leading up to a carnival. If a player has a valid reason why they could not meet the above criteria, they may submit a written request to the MSW Committee for exemption. This request needs to be submitted as soon as possible to the event. The MSW Committee will have sole discretion in determining if a player's absence from a MSW commitment is valid, based on the available information and the player's request. Please note that non-Queensland Cricket or Queensland Junior Cricket sanctioned matches will not meet the criteria of an exemption.
